CONDITIONS GOVERNING USE OF FACILITIES

1. The club and individuals must adhere to facility regulations as posted in the Centre.
2. No accommodation, other than that authorised, maybe used, disturbed or entered into.
3. **Security:** The school / club / group supervisors must ensure that all attending the indoor or outdoor facilities can be identified satisfactorily / are legitimate user or spectators.
4. The users/hirers of the facilities must ensure that a competent qualified person shall be in attendance during the period of use to supervise the members of its group, and that those present are legitimate members.
5. **Insurance :** Letterkenny Institute of Technology shall not be responsible for any loss, damage, or injury to any property, person, or persons, (including the applicants invitees), whether directly, indirectly or consequential, unless suffered by reason of negligence by LYIT , its servants or agents, and that it is reasonable that the Institute should be so liable. The applicant shall be responsible for insurance cover for use of the facilities and shall, so far as it is reasonable to do so, indemnify and keep indemnified LYIT from liability in respect of any injury to, or death of any persons, or damage to any property arising directly or indirectly out of use of the premises/facilities authorised. Applicants' insurance should also indemnify LYIT from all proceedings, costs claims and demands, in respect of any such liability, or alleged liability.

General Facility Regulations

- **Food & drink are permitted only in the canteen. Food, drink or chewing gum are not permitted in the Sport Hall.**
- Sport / School bags & coats are not permitted in hall, or left lying in reception.
- Clubs / schools are responsible for the storage and care of their own equipment.
- Visiting groups must report to reception on arrival.
- All children must be supervised by teachers / designated adults at all times.
- Groups are responsible for their own first aid & should carry a well stocked first aid box.

Minors

- Coaches/Supervisors should sign up to The Irish Sports Council & Sports Council for Northern Ireland's Code of Ethics
- **All Children U-17 must be supervised by adults at the ratio of : 1:8 for under 12 years and 1:10 over 12 years.**
- **Responsible supervision of minors is expected in all areas throughout the Centre.**
